They all have been in computer science courses both this year and last, many have taken or are currently taking Delta courses in computers, and some attended a 2 week residential program at UOP in the field of computers this summer. I hope this email makes it easier to contact them directly with information, requests, or questions while still keeping me in the loop.

We all understand that your requirements include both a 3 year commitment, being a junior or senior, and a driver's license. We found this to be extremely limiting as most juniors have just recently turned 16 and economic situations don't always allow for the expense of a driver's license. Our students for the most part have outstanding attendance with the support of their families and a community that offers free bus travel to all students. Students wanted more information on the specifics of the need for a driver's license or if reliable transportation could be substituted. Furthermore, many of these disciplined students aspire to college and are unsure about their path forward. Integrity to fulfill the 3 year commitment made almost everyone say they would not apply. I urged those that were truly interested to raise their hands and thus this email.
